
SETTING UP YOUR ARTWORK

THINGS TO KEEP IN MIND

- For still images, use JPEGs and for video content, use MP4.
- For the side panels use 1920x960px and for the tailgate use 960x960px. For content filling the full screen (billboard style) use 1920x384px.
- Avoid small text and small logos (Native resolution is 480x240px for the sides and 240x240px for the tailgate).
- Use strong, bold contrasting colours.
- Try to avoid large areas of white background. White doesn't work particularly well on LED screens. Images work much better.

PRINCIPLES OF BILLBOARD DESIGN

THESE COUPLE OF SMALL POINTS ARE EASY TO TAKE INTO ACCOUNT WHEN YOU'RE AT THE DESIGN STAGE, BUT THEY CAN HAVE A BIG IMPACT ON THE EFFECTIVENESS OF YOUR DESIGN


- Keep it simple.
- Consider layout. Will the HyperScreen be used 'Cube' style or 'Wing' style? Consider how your design will look from 50m away?
- Make your call to action and your key message stand out the most.
- Shorter words and punchy statements will get your message across quicker than large blocks of text.
- If your message takes longer than 5 seconds to make an impact, consider simplifying it.
- Use big bold text. We recommend a minimum text height of 160mm at full size.
- Use strong contrasting colours.
- Avoid large areas of white, especially backgrounds. Try to avoid using Pastel colours as they can end up looking white from a distance.
- Use images to illustrate your point. Always use high quality images with 300dpi resolution.
